



Stoped portion of mica-bearing hanging-wall zone in Queen deposit, looking west and down. This is a part of south arm of plunging trough-like pegmatite body. Note gentle rolls in hanging-wall contact; these plunge moderately west-northwest in conformity with entire body.



Crest of pegmatite body, North Cribbenville deposit. Both crest and minor rolls on flanks plunge gently west-northwest, away from observer.
