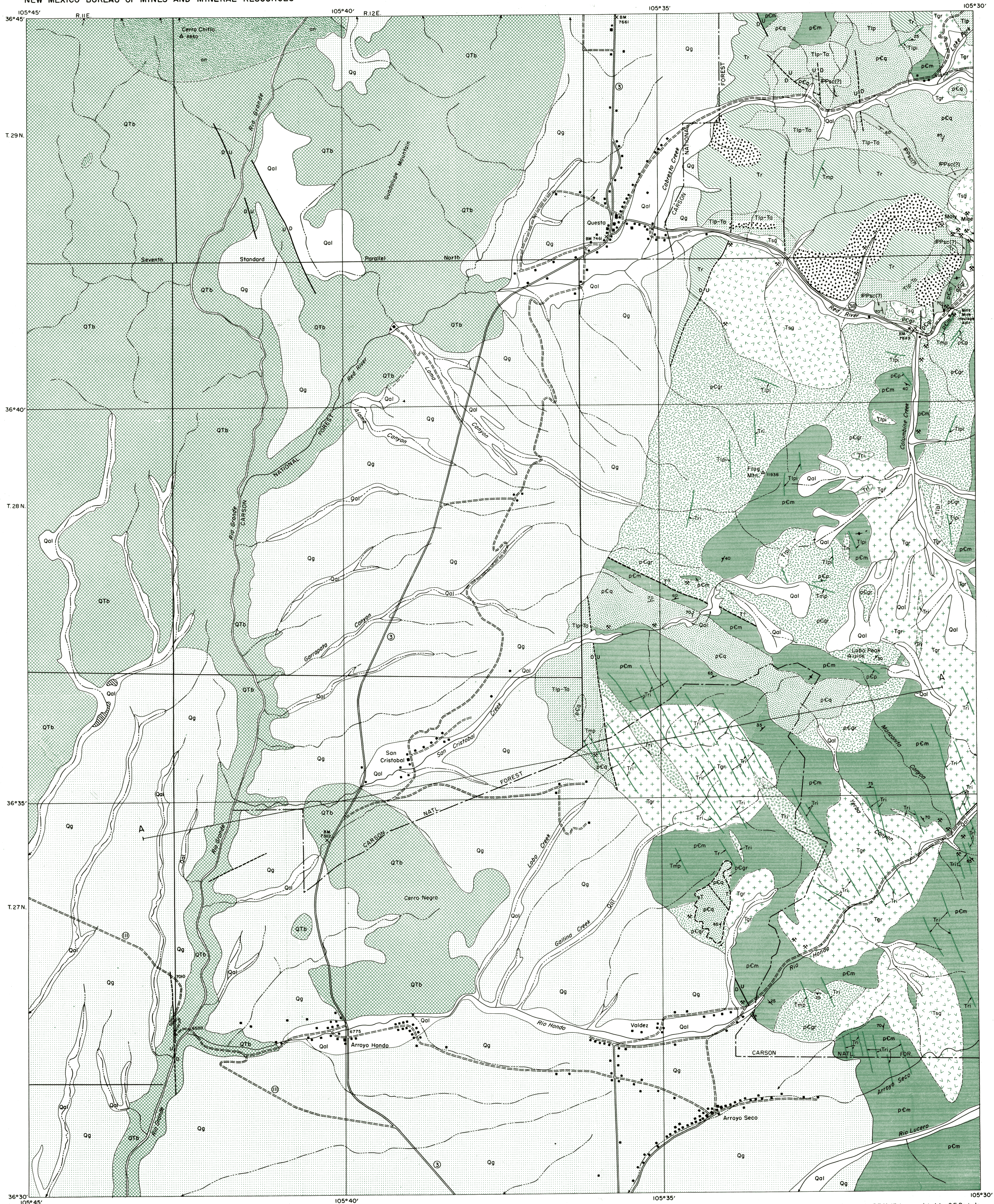




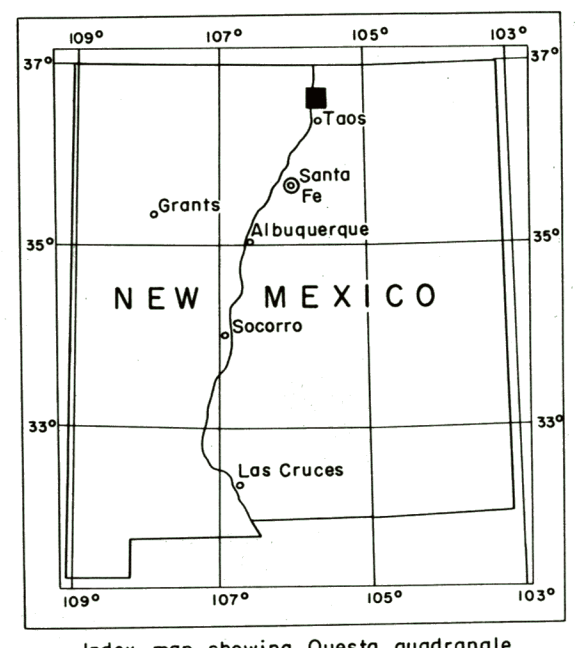

EXPLANATION

- QUATERNARY**
- Qal Valley alluvium
 - Qg Stream gravel, talus, and glacial debris
 - Coarse fan gravels
 - Andesite
 - Gray porphyritic andesite
 - Basalt
 - Dark gray basalt flows
 - ANGULAR UNCONFORMITY
 - Altered rock
 - Areas of hydrothermal alteration where the rock units were undifferentiated
 - Monzonite porphyry
 - Dikes of gray to dark green monzonite porphyry
- TERTIARY**
- Tertiary igneous complex
 - Tsg, pink soda (albite-rich) granite dikes and stocks
 - Tr, gray to light-pink rhyolite tuffs, breccias and flows
 - Tri, rhyolite dikes
 - Tgr, cream to light-pink porphyritic granite dikes and stocks
 - Tip and Tipi, Latir Peak formation, light-gray to reddish andesite and latite porphyry flows or sills (?)
 - Tipi, gray andesite and latite porphyry dikes
 - Ta, red, purple to green andesite flows, sills (?), breccias and tuffs
- PENNSYLVANIAN**
- UNCONFORMITY
 - Sangre de Cristo(?) formation
 - Red arkosic shale, sandstone, and conglomerate
 - ANGULAR UNCONFORMITY
 - Pegmatites
 - White to pink in color, usually composed of quartz, microcline, orthoclase, and some muscovite with small amounts of garnet and magnetite
 - Granite
 - Pink to cream microcline-rich granite and granite gneiss, includes pegmatite material and some migmatite
- PRECAMBRIAN**
- Metamorphic rocks
 - pEq, Cabresto(?) quartzite, gray to cream massive quartzite, in places layers of mica gneiss and graphite mica gneiss
 - pCm, undifferentiated amphibolite schist and gneiss, mica schist and gneiss, quartzite and migmatites
