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# Bibliography of New Mexico Geology and Mineral Technology 1971-1975

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# Preface

This bibliography, containing approximately 2,000 references of New Mexico geoscience and mineral technology that were issued between January 1, 1971 and December 31, 1975, is the most recent in a series of bibliographies initiated in 1955. Preceding volumes include Bulletins 43, 52, 74, 90, and 99. Work on the present bulletin began in 1973 by Judy Russell as part of her duties as editorial assistant. John Wright, a geoscience major at New Mexico Tech, was employed during 1974-76 to complete the project under the guidance of Judy Russell.

Published and unpublished materials are cited. Only items that are generally accessible and contain technical information on geoscience and mineral technology are listed. The authors searched all available titles for indications of these topics in New Mexico. Papers relating to geographical areas adjoining New Mexico were sometimes included (for example west Texas) particularly where major geologic features straddle the state boundary. Highly generalized articles of only a page or two (for example devoted to the Southwest) were excluded. The few references dated prior to 1971 are included because they were omitted in earlier bibliographies. Doubtless some references have been overlooked; we hope such omissions will be brought to our attention.

Author Section (at front)—authors are listed alphabetically. All papers under their names are listed chronologically. Where an author produced more than one paper in a single year, each paper is identified by a letter following the year. Coauthors are arranged alphabetically under the main author. Aronovici and Schneider 1972, Hoge 1970, Jelinek 1967, Lyford 1973, Phillips (ed.) 1973, and Way 1971 will be included in the 1976-80 bibliography.

*Index* (at rear)—has several comprehensive divisions as well as names of localities and counties, rocks and minerals, geologic features, mining districts, stratigraphic units, and formations. Comprehensive index headings include:

Radiometric age determinations are indexed under Geochronology. Geologic maps are indexed under the name of the county, the name of the locality (in some cases), as well as under Maps. Some divisions are cross referenced. For example, if a locality or district has more than one name, both are listed; related topics are mentioned. Subheads under the listing are limited to third order. Initials were used for primary authors only when there is more than one author with the same last name.

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
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
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
