COLONIAS DESIGNATION

HUD DEFINITION

- Must be within 150 miles from the Mexico border
- Must have been in existence prior to October 1, 1989
- Must have inadequate water, wastewater and lack of decent, safe and sanitary housing
- o Population of 10,000 or less

USDA DEFINITION

- Must be within 62 miles or 100 kilometers from the Mexico border
- Must have been in existence prior November 28, 1990
- Must have inadequate water or wastewater

COLONIAS INFRASTRUCTURE FUND

 Same as HUD definition but it includes drainage, solid waste and roads



FUNDING

- \$200,000 Congressional Direct
 Spending + \$50,000 match from the Town of Silver City
- \$300,000 Town of Silver City
- \$3.3 million 2023 Colonias Grant
- \$1.3 million ISC Reallocation
- \$1 million Local Government Division Economic Recovery Funds
- \$1.5 2025 Capital Outlay Funds

APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED

 Santa Clara 2025 Colonias Infrastructure Fund





NEXT STEPS:

DESIGN/CONSTRUCTION

- Design Commenced September 2024
- Completion of Design is December 2025
- \$3.3 CIF Funds is being used for design
- \$1.3 ISC Funds is being used for design of Santa Clara well rehabilitation
- \$1.5 Capital Outlay Funds will be utilized for Design and Construction Apache Tejo Wells
